

# Building Community Health Systems to Ensure Primary Health Care for All ICHC Declaration

We, the country representatives , participating in the Institutionalizing Community Health Conference (ICHC) in Johannesburg, South Africa in March 2017, are determined to advance the goals of health for all.

We reaffirm our commitment to the importance of community health to ensure that women and children have the opportunity to survive and thrive to transform. We uphold the overall strategies embodied in the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs), Global Strategy on Women's, Children's, and Adolescent's Health, Every Women Every Child (EWEC), and Global Strategy on Human Resources for Health (HRH), to which our governments and organizations have subscribed.

To reach the promise of health for all, we call for the following key principles to frame our actions to build a community health systems to achieve equitable and sustained improvements in health, social and development outcomes for all. These are the principles that countries must focus on to ensure that progress is made towards the goal of health for all
